MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN GOA UNIVERSITY AND ALLIANCE FRANÇAISE DE GOA

- 1. Goa University was set up as an autonomous institution under the Goa University Act, 1984 to impart teaching and promote research at the higher education level through its post-graduate departments and affiliated colleges.
- 2. Alliance Francaise de Goa was set up in Panaji, in 12.12.1988 and having branches in Margao, Vasco, and Mapusa. The mission of the Alliance Francaise is to have the students in French language and literature and award certificate and Diplomas.
- 3. Since there are objectives which are common to both Goa University French Department and Alliance Francaise de Goa, it is felt that a closer collaboration between the two institutions will be of mutual benefit to enhance the objectives of teaching and research in French.
- 4. Goa University shall welcome any valuable documentation of scientific technical and non-technical nature (such as culture, scholarships and others) from Alliance Francaise de Goa.
- 5. Inter library facilities for borrowing books from either libraries would be allowed under the agreement.
- 6. Students of either institution can use library books, journals and some other material at the library site under rules governing the library.
- 7. Borrowing for special occasions such as exhibition would be allowed under the agreement.
- 8. Students of either institutions can also use language laboratory, video films and round the clock French T.V.
