

Awards database

What is included?

An honour bestowed on the individual (fellowship of professional association, medals, certificate, etc.) for his/her life-time achievement/accomplishment by agencies, having presence on Internet in the form of a website (and the awarding agency indicating individual's accomplishment with a respect), such as

- Governments (bodies at state or national level) (e.g. Govt. of Goa, Govt. of India, French Government) and International/intergovernmental organizations (e.g. Unesco, FAO, IMF, etc)
- Professional bodies and associations (e.g. National Academy of Sciences India, Allahabad; World Association for Vedic Studies)
- Private trusts instituting awards for personnel in Education and Research and honouring individuals at specific intervals as a matter of routine (Tata Trust, INFOSYS Foundation)

What is not included? (Indicative list)

- Awards given for one work (e.g. publication of a book or best paper presentation in conference)
- Programme organizer, Chair of the session, Invited speaker in an event
- Scholarship/Fellowship for a research work instituted by governmental or private agencies (e.g. Raman Research Fellowship, UGC Research Fellowship)
- Scholarship/Fellowship instituted for a gender, religion (e.g. Women Scientist Scheme of DST, AMAN Research Fellowship Programme for Young Muslim Scholars)
- Office bearer of national/international association for a limited period
- Invitation as consultant by a private agency to receive expert services
- Invited member by the governmental agency on a committee, etc.
- Any funding support for addressing a specific issue
